**IDAHO COUNTY LIGHT & POWER COOPERATIVE'S  
ENERGY EFFICIENCY INCENTIVES PROGRAM  
Effective Oct. 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012**

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Idaho County Light & Power Cooperative Board of Directors approved the cooperative's participation in the Bonneville Power Administration's "Energy Efficiency Incentive" Programs.

In the offering, qualifying measures are to be purchased/installed by the member at the member's expense. Proof of purchase and certification of **Energy Star** rating for appliances, PTCS certification for Heat Pumps or NEEMS certification for Manufactured Homes are to be supplied with the request for reimbursement. (Note, water heaters do not have EnergyStar certification, but must meet certain specifications.) Upon verification and approval of documentation by a representative of the cooperative, a credit in the amount authorized by the BPA programs will be applied to your bill.

REQUIREMENTS: documentation to be retained by the cooperative

- 1) Proof of purchase
- 2) Proof of **Energy Star** certification (look for blue logo) for appliances.



- 3) PTCS certification for Heat Pumps or NEEM certification for Manufactured Homes.

AVAILABLE MEASURES: Links to websites providing lists of qualifying products are available from your cooperative. Following is a list of available measures and reimbursements.

- 1) CFL Light Bulbs - \$1.00/bulb (min. 5w)
- 2) EnergyStar Refrigerators and Freezers (7.75 cu. ft. or greater) - \$15
- 3) Refrigerator/Freezer Decommissioning - \$15 customer/\$85 dealer
- 4) EnergyStar Clothes Washers - \$70 if electric water heater, \$20 if not.
- 5) Showerheads - \$12.00 for 2.0 GPM or less. Limit 2 per household.
- 6) Energy efficient Electric Water Heater – Range from \$25 to \$105, depending on size (minimum 50 gal.), efficiency rating (EF) and warranty.
- 7) Heat Pumps – Air-to-Air, Ductless and Geothermal, contact us.
- 8) Energy efficient rated Manufactured Homes - \$1,150
- 9) Contact us if you are upgrading windows for an electrically heated home and we will work with you to find EEI rebates.
